Discussion will be based on the American Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology Consensus Guidelines (ASCCP). These guidelines provide up-to-date, evidence-based recommendations on how to manage women with abnormal Pap tests with the goals of minimizing the side effects of needless treatment and cancer risk. There will be discussion on the rationale for current treatment, and how to counsel and refer women with abnormal results. An overview of techniques to effectively interview the adolescent client will also be discussed.
