ABCCEDP ELIGIBILITY UPDATE

Effective October 1, 2017



ABCCEDP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ♦ Women with a household income at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Women who have no insurance or are underinsured
- Women who meet the age eligibility requirements as described below

FREE BREAST CANCER SCREENING

- Women age 40-64, screen every other year
- ♦ Women age 40-64 with breast complaints
 - ⇒ Breast complaints include bloody nipple discharge, dimpling, or discrete palpable mass.
 This does NOT include pain in the absence of other clinical findings.
- Women age 40-64 (High Risk), screen every year
 - ⇒ Personal history of breast cancer
 - \Rightarrow 1st degree relative with breast cancer
 - ⇒ Greater than 20% lifetime risk of breast cancer using BRCAPRO or Tyrer Cuzick risk assessments

- ♦ Women under age 40 (Very high breast cancer risk ONLY):
 - ⇒ Personal history of breast cancer, <u>OR</u>
 - \Rightarrow Breast mass <u>AND</u> one of the following:
 - ♦ 1st degree relative with breast cancer
 - Bloody nipple discharge expressed by provider
- Women age 65 and older with no insurance or Medicare Part A only

FREE CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING (Follow ASCCP Guidelines)

- Women age 40-64, co-test every 5 years, or Pap smear every 3 years
- ♦ Women age 30-39
 - \Rightarrow Who have had a tubal ligation
 - ⇒ Who need cervical diagnostic follow-up services for abnormal cervical cancer screening results
- Women ANY AGE with a past personal history (biopsy) of CIN ll, CIN lll, or invasive cervical cancer
- Women age 65 or older with no insurance or Medicare Part A only. Must meet ASCCP guidelines for continued screening

Add \$10,450 annually or \$871 monthly for each additional household member.
