Chairperson - Casey Daniel, PhD, MPH

Casey is an Assistant Professor of Oncologic Sciences at the University of South Alabama (USA) Mitchell Cancer Institute (MCI). She earned her undergraduate degree from Birmingham-Southern College, and Master's and Doctoral degrees in public health at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Her research focuses on behavioral epidemiology and studying health-related behaviors, including her current work to improve HPV vaccination rates and health outcomes in Alabama.
