## **Christmas Tree Guidance**

## **Technical Services Unit, Alabama Department of Public Health**

2012 NFPA 1, FIRE CODE, Section 10.14 COMBUSTIBLE VEGETATION, contains these requirements:

- 1. NATURAL CUT CHRISTMAS TREES ARE NOT PERMITTED in nursing homes, hospitals, assisted living facilities, and ambulatory surgical centers.
- 2. NATURAL LIVE CHRISTMAS TREES IN POTS are permitted in nursing homes, hospitals, congregate assisted living facilities, and ambulatory surgical centers.
- 3. ARTIFICIAL CHRISTMAS TREES and artificial vegetation shall be labeled or otherwise identified or certified by the manufacturer as being "fire retardant."
- 4. Decorations and Christmas trees shall not obstruct corridors, exit ways, or other means of egress.
- 5. Only listed electrical lights and wiring shall be used on decorations and Christmas trees.
- 6. Electric lights are prohibited on metal artificial trees.
- 7. Open flames, such as from candles, shall not be located on or near combustible materials.
- 8. Natural Christmas Trees shall not be located near fireplaces, heating vents or other heating devices that could cause the tree to be ignited.
