Sam: Okay mom! Hey....am I going to get a shot?

Susan: Yes! It's time for your yearly vaccines. We have to make sure all your vaccines are up to date before you start back to school. I have to provide a record with the day and year you got the vaccine to the school.

Sam: Okay, but how many more years do I have to do get these shots?

Susan: At least until college.

Narrator: Alabama law requires children of all ages be up to date on their immunizations before attending school. Every child needs to be vaccinated against polio, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis – also known as whooping cough – measles, mumps, rubella and chickenpox.
