

To File a Nursing Home Complaint

If you have a complaint about the care of a resident in a nursing home in Alabama, the Alabama Department of Public Health, Bureau of Health Provider Standards has made available to you ways to file a complaint with the Alabama State Survey Agency. The Alabama State Survey Agency is the agency that has regulatory responsibility for all nursing homes in the state.

Some reasons for filing a complaint would be abuse, neglect, poor care, not enough staff, unsafe or unsanitary conditions, dietary problems, or mistreatment.
