

Testing Guidance for year-long testing in non-karst areas (For homeowners testing their own homes, not in the process of buying or selling the home.)

- Test in the lowest occupied portion of the home. Follow testing instructions enclosed in the test kit.
- If the result of a long-term test equals or exceeds 4 pCi/l*, the structure should be mitigated.
- After the mitigation is complete, confirm that the mitigation was successful with a second 12-month test.
- Periodic retesting is recommended for mitigated, unmitigated and newly renovated structures.
