#### **WELCOME**

Dr. Karen Landers welcomed everyone and introduced Dr. Amber Clark-Brown as the new Medical Director for the Bureau of Health Provider Standards.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF THE MINUTES OF JULY 21, 2022**

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Minutes of July 21, 2022, as distributed; the motion carried unanimously.

#### **COVID-19 UPDATES AND VACCINATIONS**

Dr. Landers advised that over 100 million COVID cases occurred in the United States. The number of cases in Alabama had decreased over the last seven days prior to the meeting. Hospital availability for beds remained in good standing. Although the number of cases in Alabama have decreased, Alabama continued to have high community transmission levels. For Alabama, the nucleic acid implication test was about 11 percent. At the time of the update, COVID-19 was the third leading cause of death. Nationally, only 14 percent of people were up-to-date on the COVID-19 vaccine.

#### **DIRECTOR OF FOOD SERVICES/ DIETARY MANAGER WAIVER**

Denise Milledge reported the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) changed guidelines for dietary management/food service directors on October 22, 2022. In response to that change, the Alabama Nursing Home Association (ANHA) requested a waiver of regulations based on CMS requirements differing from Health Provider Standards' licensure rules. Due to this change, providers do not have adequate and appropriate staff in the facilities. The waiver is allowed through October 2023.

### **MEMBER DISCUSSION**

Members discussed the CMS release of the Quality, Safety and Oversight Group memorandum regarding Minimum Data Sets. They also discussed the possibility of CMS offsite audits.
