COVID-19 UPDATES AND VACCINES

Dr. Clark-Brown advised that there was an increase in COVID-19 numbers during the summer wave, and an increase in COVID wastewater.

Dr. Clark-Brown advised that the Monovalent vaccine availability is uncertain. Once it is available, only 25 percent will be distributed quickly.

MEMBER DISCUSSION

There was discussion about COVID -related problems occurring with patients and in nursing homes.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH IN NURSING HOMES

A partnership between the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration has created a grant to assist with the behavioral health issues in the elderly but will not include patients with dementia.

MEDICAL DIRECTOR'S CERTIFICATION

Dr. Clark-Brown discussed medica director certification requirements in California and in Maryland. Alabama does not currently require certification for medical directors to lead nursing homes.
